- The **Chaplain Ministry to Crisis Victims** - **HOW** to do and **HOW NOT** to do with crisis victims.
- The **CISM Overview** - an overview of the CISM process as relates to fire chaplaincy (only introduction).
- The **Injury and Death Notification** - **HOW TO DO** and **HOW NOT TO DO** during this important task.
- The **Introduction to Firefighter Funerals** – **HOW TO DO A FIREFIGHTER FUNERAL**; funeral customs, types of funerals, and how you can make a difference with families in the death of a firefighter.
- **HIPAA, Confidentiality, PSOB, and EAP** and other important information for being an effective chaplain.

This training is designed to train newly appointed fire chaplains (learn the right skills before you adopt the wrong ones). 
